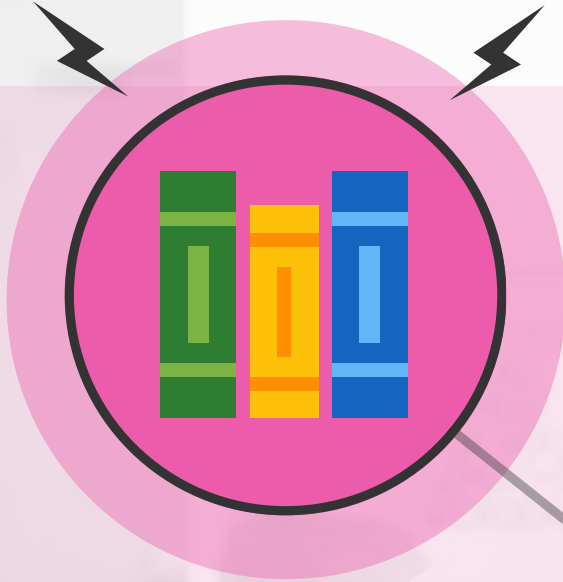


Benefits of SJHS Advanced Placement (AP) Courses



Earn college credit

By taking an AP course and scoring successfully on the related AP Exam, students can save on college expenses. Many colleges and universities nationwide offer college credit, advanced placement, or both for qualifying AP Exam scores of 3, 4, or 5. These credits can allow students to save college tuition, study abroad, or secure a second major.



Skip introductory classes

Students that know their preferred college major can take a related AP course and earn a qualifying score on the AP Exam which will help them advance and avoid introductory college courses. Taking an AP Exam unrelated to a chosen major can place a student beyond their college's general education requirements.



Save on college costs

Students who take AP courses and exams are more likely to graduate in four years, while most students take five or six years to earn bachelor's degrees at public colleges and universities. Graduating on time can save thousands or even tens of thousands of dollars in unnecessary college costs.
